Town of Golden Meadow 107 Jervis Drive Golden Meadow, LA 70357

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Golden Meadow met for their regular scheduled meeting on Monday, October 03, 2011 at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall, 107 Jervis Drive, Golden Meadow, LA 70357.

Those present were: Mayor Joey Bouziga

Councilman David Adams Councilman Mike Billiot Councilman Frank Boura Councilman Priscilla Mounic

Those absent were: Councilman Jody Cheramie

Others attending were Sgt. Charles Findley, Dudley Freeman, Lonny Lerille, Jamie Liner, Daniel Lorraine, Joseph Mickles, John Plaisance, David Rushing, and Mitchell Theriot.

Mayor Bouziga informed the Council Chief Chiasson was absent due to illness and Councilman Jody Cheramie is working.

Councilman Frank Boura presented a motion and Councilman Mike Billiot seconded approving the minutes from the Town of Golden Meadow's meeting held on September 19, 2011. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

No building permits or occupational licenses were submitted.

Mayor Bouziga presented the clean-up report as follows:

- Kirby Collins 122 Cochennic Lane Councilman David Adams presented a
 motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving the Collins
 property be granted an extension until October 17, 2011. The Council
 unanimously approved the motion as presented.
- Cory Harper 139 Theriot Street received a clean-up letter which was returned unclaimed. Councilman Mike Billiot presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving Town employees cut the grass and prepare an invoice for the expense. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.
- Harris Kieffe Estate located off Palmetto Lane received a clean-up letter with a deadline of October 17, 2011.
- Trinity Land Holdings 1012 South Bayou Drive has been cleaned.

Mayor Bouziga presented the dangerous building report as follows:

 Lincoln Martin, Sr. – 115 Mrs. Thomas Pitre Lane was delivered a dangerous building letter on September 28, 2011. The deadline to respond is October 20, 2011.

Councilman Mike Billiot presented a motion and Councilman Frank Boura seconded approving a Can Shake application for the Knights of Columbus on

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October 15, 2011 from 7:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Engineer John Plaisance presented project updates as follows:

- Sewer Phase III South Central Planning is waiting on the environmental review response and working on acquiring right-of-ways.
- Sewer Phase IV We are working on surveying.
- Sewer Phase V South Central Planning is preparing an application for funding.
- Seawall Phase II Waiting on the geotechnical review and permit approval.
- Waterlines in Oakridge Park Advertisement for bids should be prepared sometime at the end of November to install a new 8" waterline from the Jack Egle' Bridge to the pavilion and from the swimming pool to the Senior Citizen Center.

Mayor Bouziga requested adding Tropical Storm Lee, Jervis Drive, and Joseph Barbier to the agenda. No audience comments were presented. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving Mayor Bouziga add the aforesaid to the agenda. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Bouziga informed the Council he and the Town Clerk attended a meeting in Raceland regarding expenses incurred from Tropical Storm Lee. Mayor Bouziga stated the Town incurred approximately \$25,000.00 in expenses. The Town will be responsible for the expenses unless a federal disaster is declared for reimbursement.

Mayor Bouziga informed the Council he has discussed with Picciola Engineers leading the Street Resurfacing Project Phase III the possibility of turning Jervis Drive into a two lane street due to the high volume of traffic entering the street leading to the Town Hall and the Department of Motor Vehicles. Mayor Bouziga stated in order to make Jervis Drive a two lane street the adjacent property would need to be purchased. Mayor Bouziga informed the Council he has contacted six out of seven heirs and they are willing to discuss the purchase. Mayor Bouziga informed the Council the Town can only pay appraisal value for the property.

Mayor Bouziga informed the Council he was contacted by Joseph Barbier regarding the subdivision of property located on Doucet Drive. Councilman Mike Billiot presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving turning the subdivision of property over to the Planning and Zoning Commission. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Bouziga requested audience comments.

Lafourche Parish Councilman Daniel Lorraine informed the Mayor and Council the Lafourche Water District may have funding to assist the Town in funding the complete waterline in Oakridge Park.

With no further business to discuss, Councilman Frank Boand Councilman David Adams seconded adjourning this meeting	•
