The Mayor and Council of the Town of Golden Meadow met for their regular scheduled session on Monday, December 5, 2011 at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall, 107 Jervis Drive, Golden Meadow, LA 70357.

Councilman Mike Billiot presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving the minutes from the Town meeting held on November 21, 2011.

Mayor Bouziga informed the Council no building permits or occupational licenses were submitted for approval.

A complaint was received regarding tall grass and trash accumulated on the property of Kathy Spears located off Jacob Drive. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving a clean-up letter be sent to the property owner. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded approving a Planning and Zoning Commission meeting for the subdivision of property owned by Joseph Barbe located on Doucet Street. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving the regular meeting scheduled on Monday, January 2, 2011 be rescheduled on Wednesday, January 4, 2011. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Bouziga informed the Council due to the passing of Mr. Joseph Mickles the Town must appoint a representative to the Emergency 911 Board. After a brief discussion Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Frank Boura seconded approving Chief Randy Chiasson represent the Town on the Board of Emergency 911. Town Engineer John Plaisance informed the Mayor and Council there were no changes in the status of the ongoing projects.

Mayor Bouziga reminded the Council of the Public Hearing and Special Meeting scheduled on Monday, December 12, 2011 beginning at 6:45 P.M. and 7:00 P.M. for the amending of the 2011 Budget and approval of the 2012 Budget of Revenues and Expenditures for the Town.

Mayor Bouziga informed the Council he received the appraisal for the Betty Ledet and family property in the amount of \$21,500.00. Councilman Mike Billiot presented a motion and Councilman Frank Boura seconded approving a letter be sent to the property owners making an offer to purchase the property. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Bouziga requested adding Lafourche Parish Water District and South Coast Gas to the agenda. No audience comments were presented. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Mike Billiot seconded approving Mayor Bouziga add the aforesaid to the agenda. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Bouziga presented pictures of Bob's Lane showing damage to the newly resurfaced street due to a water leak repair by the Lafourche Parish Water District. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Frank Boura seconded approving Mayor Bouziga send a letter to the Lafourche Parish Water District informing them when water leak repairs are conducted any damages to the street must be repaired according to the specifications of Lafourche Parish for Town streets. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Bouziga presented pictures of Picciola Lane showing damage to the newly resurfaced street due to the installation of a natural gas line by South Coast Gas. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Frank Boura seconded approving Mayor Bouziga send a letter to South Coast Gas informing them when gas lines are installed or repairs are conducted any damages to the street must be repaired according to the specifications of Lafourche Parish for Town streets. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Bouziga requested audience comments.

Mr. Dudley Freeman requested the Town look into having property owners clean their property located along Alex Plaisance Blvd. Mr. Freeman also stated Golden Meadow is a beautiful Town to live in. Mayor Bouziga informed Mr. Freeman he and the Town Engineer have discussed having property cleaned from Alex Plaisance Blvd. to the drainage canal.
