The Mayor and Council of the Town of Golden Meadow met for their regular rescheduled meeting on Wednesday, September 3, 2014 at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall, 107 Jervis Drive, Golden Meadow, LA 70357.

Mayor Joey Bouziga called this meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Councilman David Adams led everyone in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Willis Toups led everyone in prayer.

Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Lindberg Lorraine seconded approving the minutes from the meetings held on August 18, 2014. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.
