The Mayor and Council of the Town of Golden Meadow met for their regular scheduled meeting on Monday, April 6, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall, 107 Jervis Drive, Golden Meadow, LA 70357.

Mayor Joey Bouziga called this meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Councilman David Adams led everyone in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Jody Cheramie led everyone in prayer.

No Occupational Licenses were submitted for approval.

Upon unanimous approval of the Board of Adjustments, Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Lindberg Lorraine seconded approving a building permit application for Shelly Louviere, 1014 South Bayou Drive to construct a fence requiring a variance from 30" to 40". The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded approving a letter be send to Ms. Gloria Bouzigard requesting her attendance at the Council meeting scheduled on April 20, 2015 to discuss the cleaning of her property located at 112 Delgrandile Lane. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga informed the Council Mr. Roy Borne continues to demolish the dangerous building at 2228 South Bayou Drive.

No updates were presented regarding public nuisance vehicles.

Due to the absence of Town Engineer John Plaisance, Mayor Joey Bouziga presented the project report as follows:

- Seawall Phase III remains in the planning and design process.
- North Plant Upgrades plans should be complete at the end of this month.
- Town Hall Turnaround plans should be complete at the end of this month.

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- Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving Seawall Project Phase 1-A Change Order No. 2 in the amount of \$6,535.00. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.
- Seawall Phase II was reimbursed and the walkthrough has been completed.
- Mayor Joey Bouziga informed the Council he attended a meeting to begin an application for the funding of Seawall Phase IV.

Attorney Bryce Autin was absent.

Mr. Tim Callais presented building plans to the Mayor and Council to forward to Town Engineer John Plaisance for review and recommend the required zoning changes. Mrs. Mary Plaisance and Mr. Kip Plaisance addressed the Council regarding their concerns for the gated community plans Mr. Tim Callais has presented.

Councilman Willis Toups presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving an advertisement for pool workers. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga requested Council members inform the Town Clerk if they are planning to attend LMA Municipal Day Conference at the end of the month.

Councilman Jody Cheramie presented a motion and Councilman Willis Toups seconded approving a clean-up letter to the owners of property located at the end of Texas Road due to a complaint. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman Willis Toups presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded approving the advertisement of a notice of Public Meeting on May 18, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall, 107 Jervis Drive, Golden Meadow, LA 70357 to adopt the 2015 ad valorem taxes for the Town of Golden Meadow as follows: General Alimony 5.97, Levee Maintenance 5.09, Drainage Maintenance 5.09 and Street Maintenance 5.00. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman David Adams addressed the Council regarding the Town's fine schedule. After a brief discussion Councilman Jody Cheramie presented a motion and Councilman Lindberg Lorraine seconded approving Councilman David Adams and Chief Reggie Pitre research fine scheduled from other municipalities and parishes and report at the next Council meeting. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman David Adams requested adding a streetlight at the end of LaSalette Drive. Councilman Priscilla Mounic presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded approving the installation of a streetlight at the end of LaSalette Drive. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga requested Entergy Representatives inspect a tree on B & R Lane which passes through the power lines.
