The Mayor and Council of the Town of Golden Meadow met for their regular scheduled meeting on Monday, May 4, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall, 107 Jervis Drive, Golden Meadow, LA 70357.

Mayor Joey Bouziga called this meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Councilman David Adams led everyone in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Jody Cheramie led everyone in prayer.

Councilman Willis Toups presented a motion and Councilman Lindberg Lorraine seconded approving the minutes from the previous meeting held on Monday, April 20, 2015 . The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga presented a building permit for Mary Rotolo to sub-divide property. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving this permit to be turned over to the Planning and Zoning Commission for further review. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga informed the Council Shane Rogers has campers located on his property with no permits and needs to be notified. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Lindberg Lorraine seconded approving a letter be sent to Shane Rogers in reference to his campers requiring he needs permits. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

No Occupational Licenses were submitted for approval.

Mayor Joey Bouziga presented the clean up reports as follows:

- Gloria Bouzigard – 112 Delgrandile Lane continues to clean her property.
- William Good & Others – Corner of S. Alex Plaisance and Texas Road. The grass has not been cut. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving the grass to be cut. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented
- Ashley Adams – 505-C North Bayou Drive – deadline to cut and clean is May 20, 2015

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- Gale Cheramie – 130 Terrebonne Lane was sent a clean - up letter and Keith Cheramie representing Ms. Cheramie stated he will cut the grass as soon as he has help from a relative.

Mayor Joey Bouziga presented the Public Nuisance/Abandoned Vehicles report:

Engineer John Plaisance presented the project report as follows:

- North Sewer Plant Upgrades remains in the planning stage
- Sewer Phase IV - waiting on servitudes
- Sewer Phase V – funding approved from LCDBG
- Seawall Phase I Repairs – have been completed
- Seawall Phase II – has been completed and the Town has been reimbursed
- Seawall Phase III – remains in the planning stages and waiting on property owner
- Fuel System Canopy – a quote was submitted for \$ 5720.00 to install sides next to the fuel tanks. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Lindberg Lorraine seconded approving the quote \$ 5720.00 to install the sides next to the fuel tanks. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.
- Capital Outlay Grant – waiting for funding approval for lift station upgrades
- Skate Board Park – should be ready to advertise for design service
- Town Hall Improvements Project – back in progress
- Water Enrichment Grant - application has been submitted and still waiting
- Pool Repairs – the pool will be cleaned and back for testing

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Mayor Joey Bouziga informed the Council of the Planning and Zoning Commission meeting scheduled for Monday, May 18, 2015 at 4:00 P.M. at Town Hall to re-zone property for CDS, LLC located on South Alex Plaisance Blvd.

Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving from the public hearing a resolution to Adopt Environmental Information Document (EIC) for Sewer Phase V. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving from the public hearing a resolution to adopt the submission of an application for funding under the State of Louisiana DY 2016-17 LCDBG and selected the project for sewer. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman Willis Toups presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded approving the Bond Sinking Fund checking account be closed. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman Lindberg Lorraine congratulated Drake Rogers, Jr. on passing his sewer test and on a job well done.

Mayor Joey Bouziga requested adding to the agenda a replacement on the Planning and Zoning/Variance Commission. Councilman Priscilla Mounic presented the motion and Councilman Willis Toups seconded approving Mayor Joey Bouziga add the aforesaid to the agenda. Councilman Priscilla Mounic presented the motion and Council David Adams seconded approving Mayor Joey Bouziga's recommendation of Craig Boudreaux to replace Rodney Ledet on the Planning and Zoning/Variance Commission. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman Jody Cheramie requested adding to the agenda a grass complaint on the Ed Diaz property located on South Bayou Drive. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Lindberg Lorraine seconded approving Councilman Jody Cheramie add the aforesaid to the agenda. Councilman Jody Cheramie presented a motion and Councilman Lindberg Lorraine seconded approving a clean-up letter be sent. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman Willis Toups requested adding to the agenda a complaint of overhanging tree branches located on Rue Pouche Vide. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded approving Councilman Willis Toups add the aforesaid to the agenda. Mayor Joey Bouziga stated the town crew will review the hanging tree branches and if they can't cut it we will contact Entergy for further assistance.

Mayor Joey Bouziga called for audience comments.

Mr. Larry Griffin addressed the Mayor and Council in regards to speeders in his street. A brief discussion took place and his concern will be reviewed for speed humps.

Mr. Tim Callais addressed the Mayor and Council on emergency vehicles driving at a high rate of speed. After a brief discussion Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded approving a letter be sent the Lafourche Parish

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Fire District Chief and Captain to the attend the next council meeting in regards to this matter. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga thanked Frank Boura on a job well done for drainage work located at OLOPS Church.

With no further business to discuss Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Willis Toups seconded adjourning this meeting at 7:37 P.M. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.
