Mayor Joey Bouziga instructed everyone to refrain from cell phone use until the meeting adjourns.

Mayor Joey Bouziga presented both the current ordinance and the proposed amended ordinance. The proposed amended ordinance would include a State Statue regarding repeat offenders of the GM high weeds and grass and clean-up ordinance and also states that a person found in violation of any provisions of this ordinance more than once in any six month period shall be cited for a misdemeanor. Mayor Joey Bouziga stated he would like to see the Town hire a contract grass cutter to take care of the properties not being taken care of by the property owners.

Mayor Joey Bouziga requested audience comments.

Mr. Kevin Cheramie stated he believes hiring a contract grass cutter would be a move in the right direction.

With no further business to discuss, Councilman Jody Cheramie presented a motion and Councilman Lindberg Lorraine seconded approving this public hearing adjourn at 6:59 P.M. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.
